Set up inside: Tuesday Noon to 8:00 PM –forklift available; Wednesday 8:00 to 11:30 AM – hand carry or carts are available. Outside exhibitors will be scheduled starting Monday, the 14<sup>th</sup>. All inside exhibitors must be moved out of the auditorium by 8:00 PM Thursday.

In conjunction with WOMEN IN CONSTRUCTION WEEK in Maine, companies are encouraged to honor their women employees. A picture of a woman, or women, her/their position with the company, and the company logo are displayed on a 3' X 5' banner that will be hung with others around the perimeter of the auditorium, to help celebrate WIC Week. Cost of WIC banner is \$250 for a three-year period.

Deadline for 2010 Exhibitors to reserve their space is February 15, and be listed in the Program. New exhibitors will be assigned booth space following the deadline and will be listed in the program. Deadline for being listed in the Program Supplement is April 10.

Complimentary tickets, posters and brochures will be distributed to exhibitors the first week of March. Requests for additional tickets should be received by Feb. 23. Distribution of the complimentary tickets is key to having prospective attendees aware of the dates and times of the show, and exhibitors are encouraged to distribute as many as possible to their customers and clients. **Electronic Tickets** will also be available in early March as well, and can be emailed in order to reach more attendees.

The deadline for providing names of exhibitor representatives working during the show is April 1. Changes must be provided no later than **April 10** to avoid congestion and delays checking in at the Construction Expo office in the Civic Center Lobby. Each representative must register upon arrival at the show, before they enter the Auditorium or Outside Display Area.

Companies wishing to sponsor a seminar must be signed up by February 15 to be included in the Program. Sponsors are encouraged to promote their seminars to their targeted attendees as much as possible. Cost of seminar rooms are \$50 per two hour segment.
