SCHOLARSHIP QUALIFICATIONS AND GUIDELINES

1. The scholarships are available to applicants planning to enroll, or already enrolled, in a construction oriented 4 (four) year program at any University or College, or a 1 (one) or 2 (two) year Technical or Community College in a full time program.
2. Recipients are selected on the basis of the applicants financial need and scholastic achievement.
3. Applicants shall complete the scholarship application completely. If any space is left blank, there must be an explanation to avoid being disqualified.
4. Scholarships are presented to applicants who are planning to make construction their life work. Therefore, applicants are required to write in at least 50 (fifty) words, the reasons they have chosen this field.
5. Two letters of recommendation are required:
  - a. A faculty member of the student's school who is familiar with his/her academic achievements and capabilities.
  - b. An individual from the applicant's community (not a relative) who knows the applicant well.
6. A transcript of the applicant's prior year(s) post secondary grade transcripts must accompany the application, including the first half of the current year.
7. If applicant has any "special circumstances", be specific in the details in the space provided on this application.
8. Applications must be **received** by the Scholarship Committee **NO LATER THAN MAY 1**. Applications and required documents should be mailed to:
